Found in soaps, cleansers, deodorant, antiperspirant. Fragrance Parabens Diazolidinyl urea DMDM hydantoin Aluminum (in antiperspirant) Safer tip: use deodorant instead of antiperspirant 	 Lead: a contaminant in lipstick. Not on label. Highest levels found in Maybelline and L'Oreal. High lead levels in: NARS, CoverGirl, StarGazer. Mercury (thimerosal) in eye products Petroleum distillates in mascara Talc in loose powders Fragrance Parabens BHA (Butylated hydroxyanisole) 	• Fragrance • Parabens • Ingredients with "-eth-" in the name (ie: sodium laureth sulfate), often in bubble bath or shampoo • Formaldehyde-releasers (often in baby wipes): • Bronopol (2-Bromo-2-Nitropropane-1,3-Diol) • DMDM hydantoin • Imidazolidinyl urea
cosmetic products prior to marketing. Claims such as "natural," "organic," or "dermatologist-tested" are unregulated and undocumented. Good to Do Read ingredients (they must be listed). Look for USDA Organic Seal (no synthetic chemicals). Check ewg.org/skindeep for product hazard ratings. Use fewer products. Choose those with simpler ingredients.
